The Liturgical Year

The Church's year is called the liturgical year and is a cycle of seasons and days when we remember the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

The Liturgical Year

The liturgical year has these seasons:

1. Advent
2. Christmas
3. Ordinary Time
4. Lent
5. Easter Trident - Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, Easter Vigil
6. Easter
7. Ordinary Time
