We have not left Key Stage 2 out, we are using Sports Premium money to ensure that there are coaches during lunch time each day to teach the children alternatives to football. Sometimes, issues arise from football, where some children are made to feel that they cannot play if their skills are not as good as others or if there are only boys playing. We believe at SFX that ALL boys and girls are entitled to be treated equally, so we expect children with a range of skills to join in and want to ensure that our children know that there are not separate acivities for boys or girls. In living out the Catholic Social Teaching Principles of dignity and peace, means that we treat others with respect and equality in ALL ways is important to us. Please discuss this with your child at home, we need your support in making sure that playtimes are a time when children are free to play safely and fairly with one another and that they will have fun.
