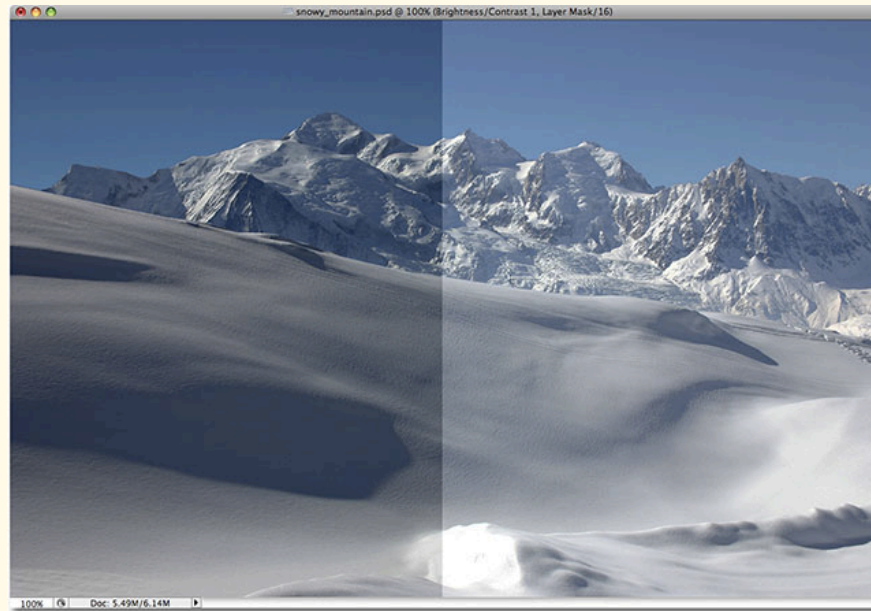

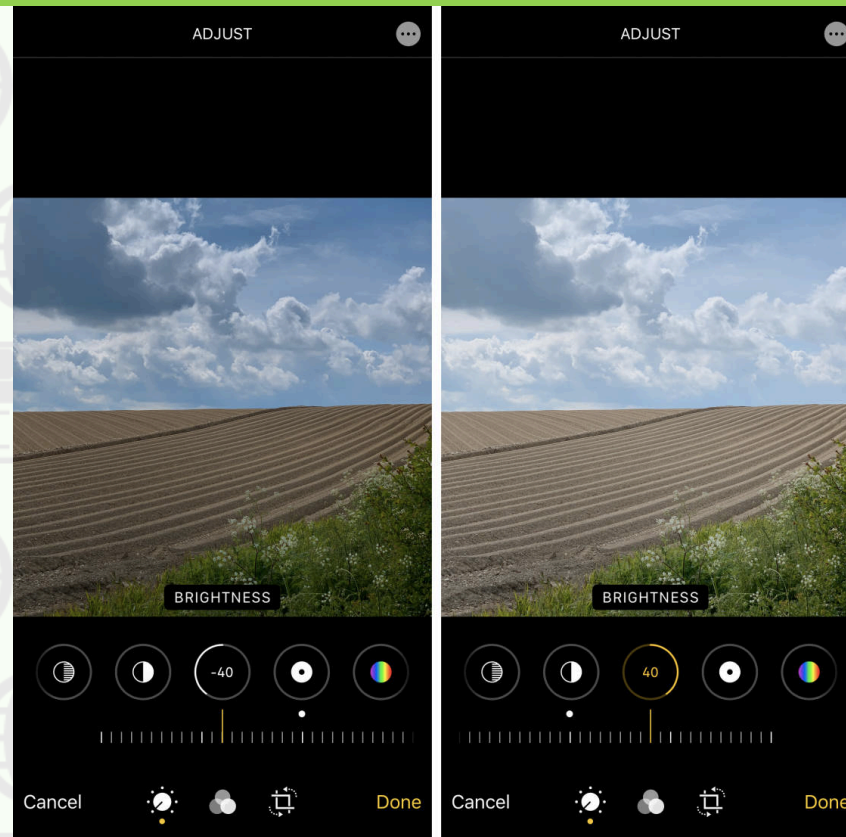


Why do we take photographs?



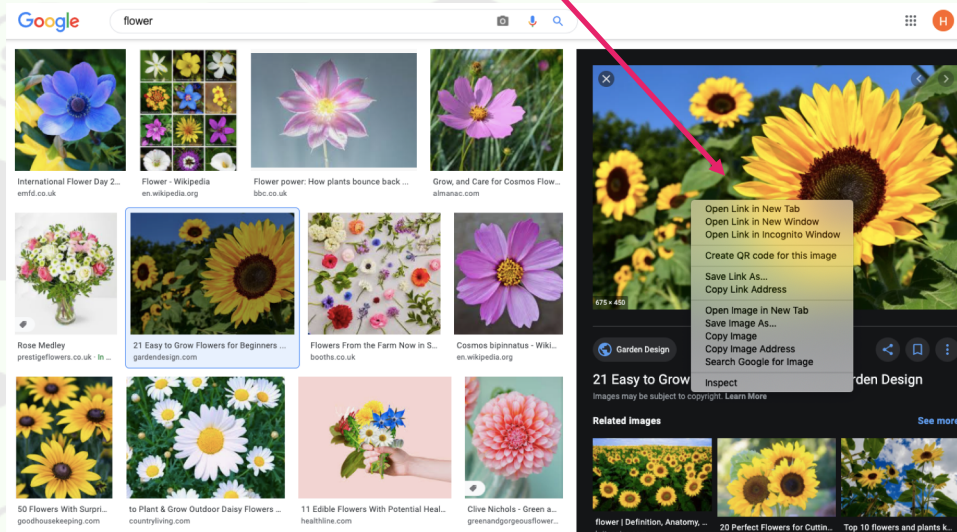
Why do we enhance photos?

Enhance- to increase or improve the quality



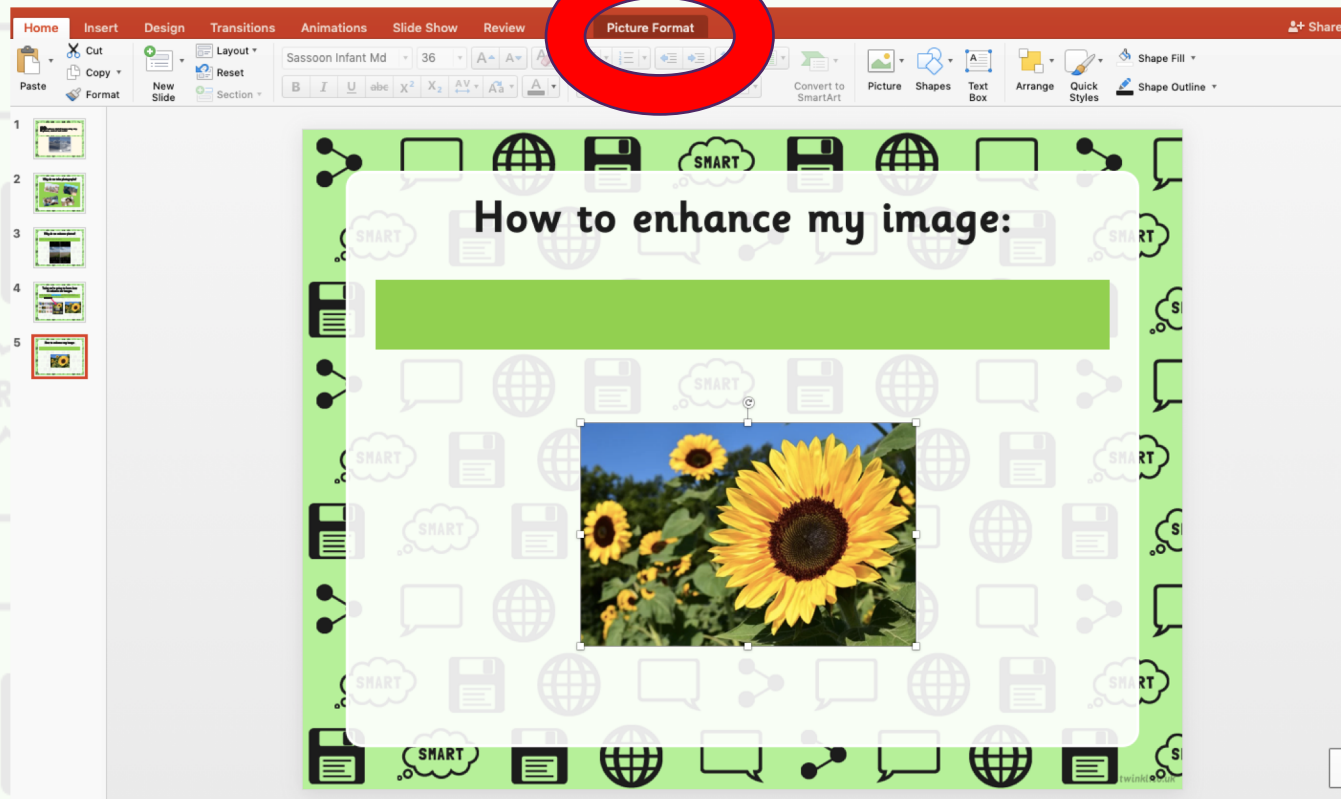
Today we're going to learn how to enhance our images.

Firstly, I'm going to go to www.google.co.uk and find an image I want to enhance today. I've chosen an image of a flower and I've right clicked on the image to copy and paste it onto the PowerPoint.



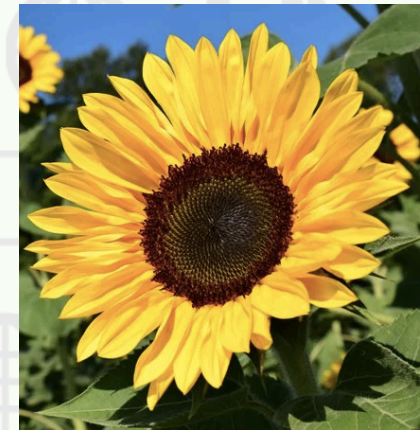
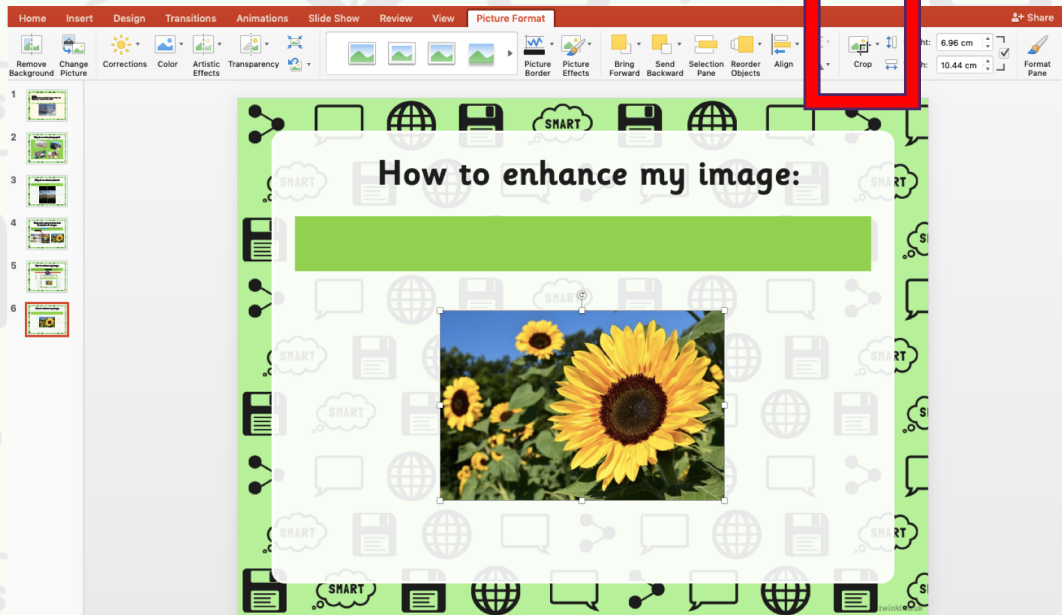
How to enhance my image:

Once you have your chosen image on your slide, click on your image and you should see at the top of the screen: Picture format. Click on this.



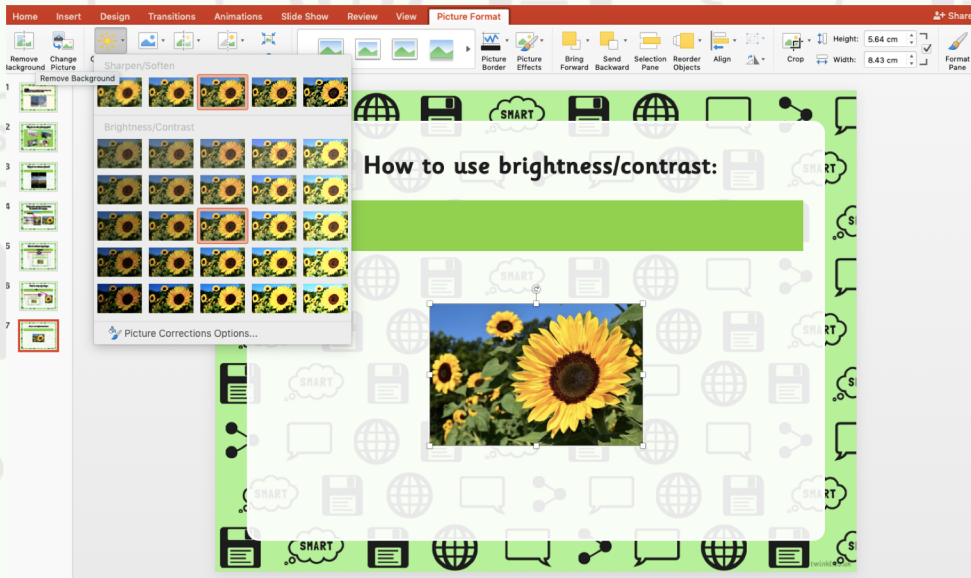
How to crop my image:

At the top of the page, click on **crop**. This will allow you to cut out parts of the image you do not want, by dragging the edges into the centre with a right click. It should now look something like this...



How to use brightness/contrast:

Just like before, right click on your image, then click picture format at the top of the screen. Look towards the left and you'll see a picture of the sun. Click on it and it will show you brightness/contrast. There are different options for you to choose from. I've chosen this one.



How to resize my image:

If you click on your image, you'll see small white squares appear around it. Right click on one of these points to drag in inwards or outwards to change the size. **If you right click this arrow**, you can change the angle of the shape.
