







Today we're going to learn how to enhance our images.

Firstly, I'm going to go to <u>www.google.co.uk</u> and find an image I want to enhance today. I've chosen an image of a flower and I've right clicked on the image to <u>copy and paste</u> it onto the PowerPoint.





How to crop my image:

At the top of the page, click on <u>crop</u>. This will allow you to cut out parts of the image you do not want, by dragging the edges into the centre with a right click. It should now look something like this...

How to use brightness/contrast:

Just like before, <u>right click on your image</u>, then <u>click picture format</u> at the top of the screen. Look towards the left and you'll see a picture of the sun. Click on it and it will show you brightness/contrast. There are different options for you to choose from. I've chosen this one.



How to resize my image:


If you click on your image, you'll see small white squares appear around it. Right click on one of these points to drag in inwards or outwards to change the size. <u>If you right click this arrow</u>, you can change the angle of the shape.
